

To qualify for a wish, a child must meet these criteria at the time of referral:

- 1. Older than 2½ years and under 18 years
- 2. Has not received a wish from another wish-granting organization
- 3. Diagnosed with a condition currently placing the child's life in jeopardy

Usually qualifying Gastroenterology conditions:

- Bowel/Intestinal transplant
- Chronic progressive liver disease with decompensation
- Hepatopulmonary syndrome
- Inflammatory bowel disease resulting in short gut disease with:
 - o Prolonged parenteral support
 - o Complications resulting from immunosuppressive therapy or surgery

- Liver failure
- Liver transplantation (within one year of transplant)
- Malignancy or inherited premalignant conditions
- Portal hypertension
- Short bowel syndrome or intestinal failure requiring prolonged parenteral (TPN) support
- Status post liver transplant (with ongoing life-threatening complications)

Other conditions that may be eligible for a wish with complicating comorbidities:

- Atresia of bile ducts
- Complications from immunosuppressive therapy
- Crohn's disease
- Hirschsprung's disease

- Pancreatitis
- Ulcerative colitis
- Many other conditions not listed
