As we look back at this past year, our chapter reached many milestones.

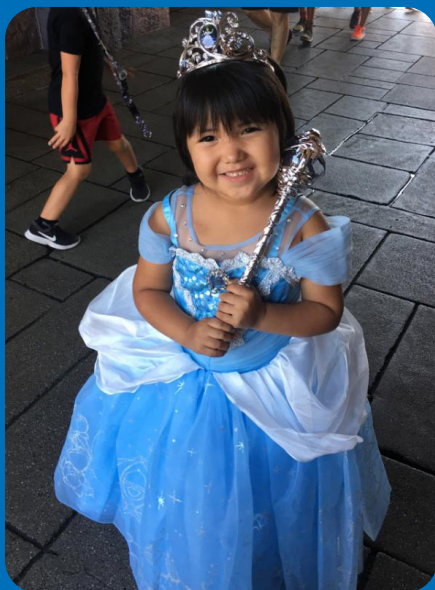
We know that a wish experience provides hope, strength and inspiration for children battling critical illnesses.

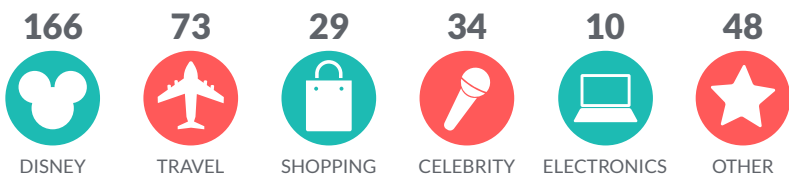

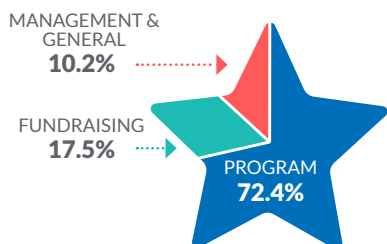

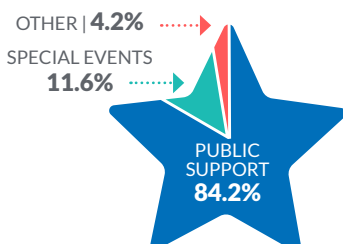
Our Funds

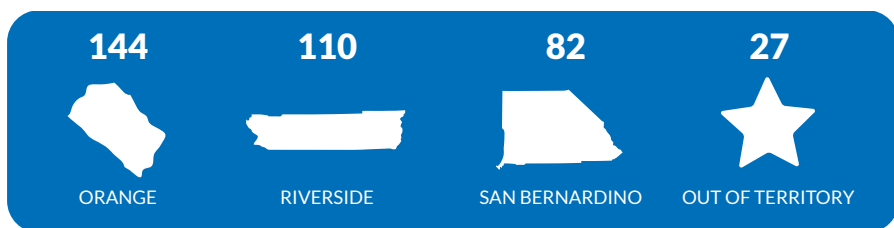
Our People

Our organization heavily relies on our volunteers to deliver our mission. Without the support, dedication and passion of these individuals, we would not be able to create life-changing wish experiences for children and their families.

This year 785 volunteers supported our mission, 363 of them as wish granters. Encompassing Orange, Riverside and San Bernardino counties, these volunteers help grant a wish every 24.3 hours.

When you add in the support of nearly 27 office volunteers and interns, complementing our paid staff throughout the year, our volunteers contributed more than 10,200 hours in fiscal year 19, contributing more than \$300k of donated time!
