RALEIGH, N.C. (April 15, 2020) — 6-year-old Delaney from Wake County, who received a solid organ transplant, wished to have a backyard playset. Her wish will be revealed, thanks to generous support from Raleigh-based business **Backyard Playground**, on Friday, April 17, 2020 beginning at 4:00pm. Delaney's wish celebration has a different look due to the gathering restrictions from COVID-19. Make-A-Wish Eastern North Carolina and a community of volunteers and supporters will join together for a driving parade to help celebrate with Delaney and her family. Right now, about 30 cars, including some police officers and fire trucks, have committed to participate, and several surprises for Delaney and her family are planned as well. *This event will maintain safe social distancing. All media are invited to attend the wish delivery celebration.*

This event is part of the national Make-A-Wish "Messages of Hope" campaign, focused on sharing encouragement and support with wish kids waiting during the COVID-19 restrictions. "Messages of Hope" gives supporters and the general public alike a fun, easy way to support children with critical illnesses by writing, recording, or photographing themselves delivering messages of encouragement.
