Now 18, Scott defies odds and takes on every opportunity to challenge himself, putting his whole heart into everything he does. Scott knew he wanted his wish to take him to the peak of happiness – the ski slopes, of course.

This winter, Scott, his parents and his two sisters traveled from their home in Wexford, PA, to Jackson Hole, WY. There, they were welcomed to the Snake River Lodge near the Teton Range. Scott was free to ski as much as he wanted. Naturally, he was the first one on and the last one off the ski lift every day. Thankfully, they had many "bluebird" days, perfect weather for trailing through the mountains.

Because Scott loves a challenge, Make-A-Wish® arranged for him to have a private lesson with the head instructor of the advanced "Steep and Deep" ski camp. The expert guide took him through the ins and outs of the most difficult slopes. "They took him places you don't even think you can ski," Scott's dad said. After he graduates high school, Scott hopes to attend the University of Utah, conveniently located near the mountains so he can continue his passion while pursuing an education.

The best part of the trip, Scott's dad explained, was that Scott was able to enjoy what he loves while also spending valuable time with family. This trip gave Scott and his loved ones a much needed retreat to find hope on the slopes.

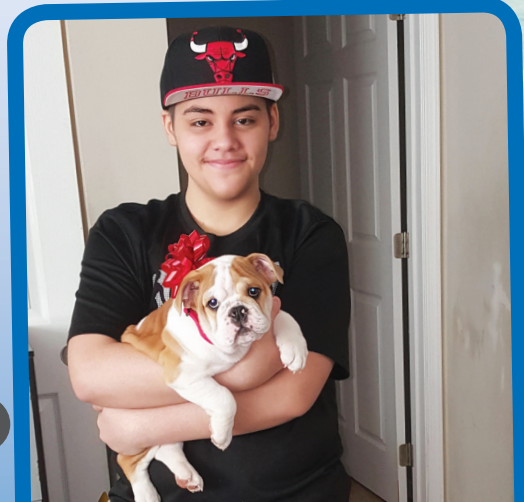

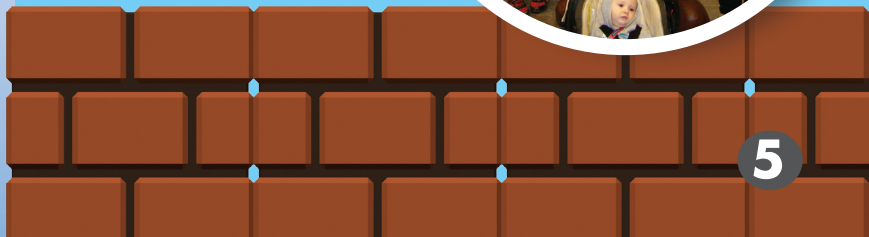


Last October, four-year-old Ethan of Pittsburgh, PA, was granted his Super Mario-sized wish to go to the Nintendo World Store in New York City.

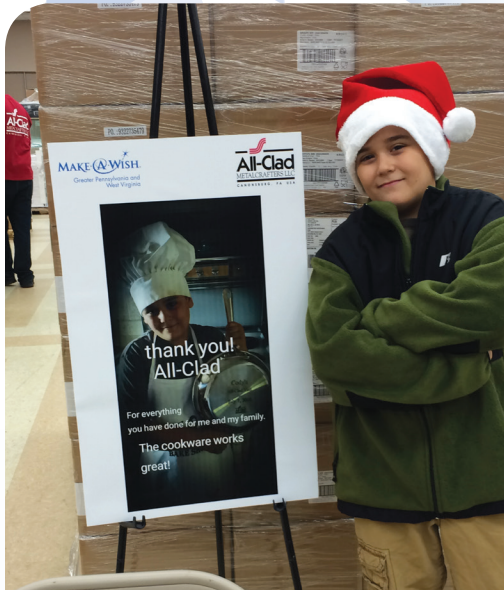

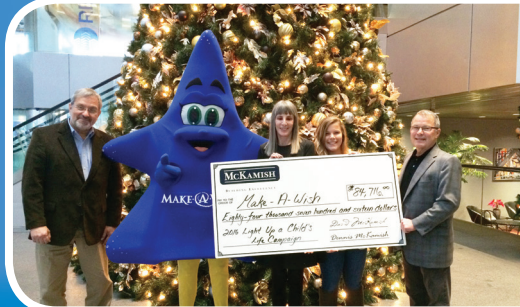
