*At school, teachers call six-year-old Anna “mermaid,” and she beams with a smile. She got this nickname, not because of the nautical pearl necklace she wears or her long wavy hair, but because last year, she had her wish granted to become one of these undersea beauties.*

No one would guess that, in such a small number of years, Anna has undergone nearly a dozen surgeries for her congenital heart disease – one that makes her little body work extra hard every day to live and play.

But Anna’s mom said that hasn’t stopped her from dreaming. When Anna’s wish-granting volunteers asked her what her wish was, Anna proclaimed, “I want to be a mermaid.” Anna’s mom admitted that she was surprised; “I thought, ‘Well, that’s a new one.’”

As it turned out, Anna’s wish couldn’t have been a better fit. “She’s a little fish in the summer,” Anna’s mom said.

With that in mind, the family took off for Boca Raton, Florida to grant Anna’s marine dream. As she walked along the beach, Anna saw real-life mermaids in the distance. Anna was thrilled to meet her favorite mythical creature, and with a tail of her own, she was ready to dive in the water.

“It’s amazing. If you knew how far she’s come from how sick she has been, to this healthy six-year-old who just wants to run around and swim with mermaids,” Anna’s mom said. “It’s awe-inspiring.”

This wish gave Anna a chance to live without the limits of her condition and continues to make an impact on her today.

“She still talks about her wish all the time,” Anna’s mom said. “The mermaids gave her a matching necklace and she never takes it off...This experience will stay with her for the rest of her life.”

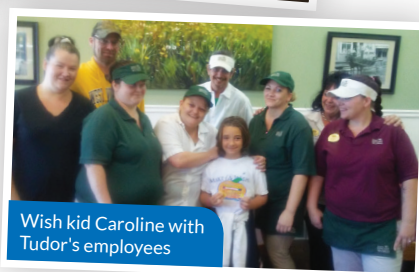

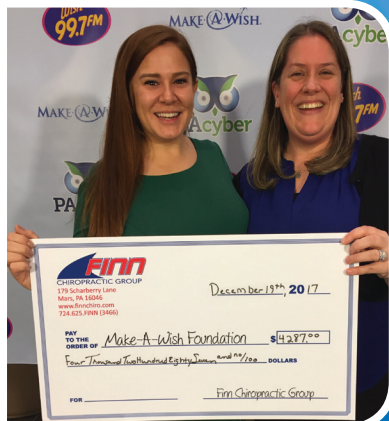
