She was just beginning to “scoot around” when her Mother noticed she was becoming very lethargic. This led to a four month hospitalization where she



underwent 10 surgeries during this time. Sanai suffered a stroke during the final surgery which was neurologically devastating. She is now extremely delayed, non-verbal, does not walk, and has failing vision. Sanai’s mother and family are adjusting to this change and learning to read her new expressions. Her mother knows that Sanai “loves hugs, kisses and snuggles”.

Sanai is a very social little girl who enjoys the company around her. She is brought the most joy when her family is holding and hugging her, as cuddles are her absolute favorite. She also loves to listen to happy songs and she really enjoys warm water.

Sanai’s Mother knows how much she enjoyed being in the water when she had the chance to visit Hawaii. When it was time to decide on a wish, it was well known that Sanai would love to go to a warm beach.
