Aspen's Story



As a parent, there are four words you never want to hear: 'your child has cancer.'

In April 2019, these are the very words wish kid Aspen's parents heard for their little girl Aspen at just six years old.

The story began when Aspen's parents noticed a lump on her neck. She had a cold at the time so they thought it was associated with that. When she wasn't getting better, her parents decided it was best to take her to the doctor. The doctor ordered an ultrasound which detected something different or abnormal. After being referred to several different specialists, they received the news that the lump in Aspen's neck was indeed cancer. Words that immediately threw them into a medical vortex of treatment plans to cure her of this terrible diagnosis.

Within days, Aspen had surgery to remove the tumor from her neck. A team of surgeons were able to remove the mass that was the size of a large potato. It was a delicate, intricate surgery. Following surgery, Aspen was left with vocal cord paralysis, the inability to sweat on her left side and a droopy left eye.

There was no time to rest as her medical team put her on a plan of recovery. The tumor had pressed on her vocal cords for so long that she was unable to eat or drink without aspirating. She immediately began doing intense physical, occupational and speech therapy to regain functions she had lost. She remained in the hospital for a month and continued out-patient treatment for many weeks to months following.

Cancer found a mighty fierce opponent in Aspen. This personality trait served her well.

Aspen set a goal for herself that she was going to start Kindergarten able to eat what she wanted and with no feeding tube. She worked very hard on this goal. When she started school in August, she had almost mastered all foods and drinks. After 137 days Aspen had her NG tube removed -- the day after she started kindergarten.

Aspen loves chickens. To get her through this difficult time, her sister started a social media petition when she was hospitalized to have people send her stuffed chickens/animals. Her hospital room was soon FULL of them. Her other sister started buying her real chickens to have on the family farm. Aspen became known as the chicken farmer in her family. At one point she had over 80 chickens and ducks. She even became a little entrepreneur selling her eggs to friends and family.

When Make-A-Wish met with Aspen and her family about her very own wish, it was an easy decision...she wanted a playhouse for her and her chickens.

Because of COVID-19, it took a while for Aspen's wish to become a reality, but the day finally arrived for Aspen's wish to be granted on World Wish Day, April 29, 2021.



The town of North Bend, population 1,213, came together to make it very special. Aspen was made to feel like royalty that day. She was escorted from school to her home in a fire truck with the state patrol and the sheriff's department leading the way. Aspen and her parents were blindfolded on the way to the house. When they arrived, they stepped off the fire truck, and removed the blindfolds to see the playhouse completed with an attached chicken coop for her feathered friends, plus flower boxes and a chalkboard wall.

"Make-A-Wish afforded Aspen so many opportunities that nothing else in life ever will," said Kris, Aspen's mom.



Kris continued, "Since her wish, Aspen has been a part of the Make-A-Wish Annual Blue Jean Ball, she has been interviewed, spoken lines for commercials, attended and auctioned off her eggs at galas and so much more."

"These experiences would never have been possible without Make-A-Wish," Kris said. "We are just ordinary people from a

small town, made to feel extraordinary. Thank you to everyone who supports Make-A-Wish and their mission. Allowing sick children to close their eyes and make a wish is an indescribable experience."

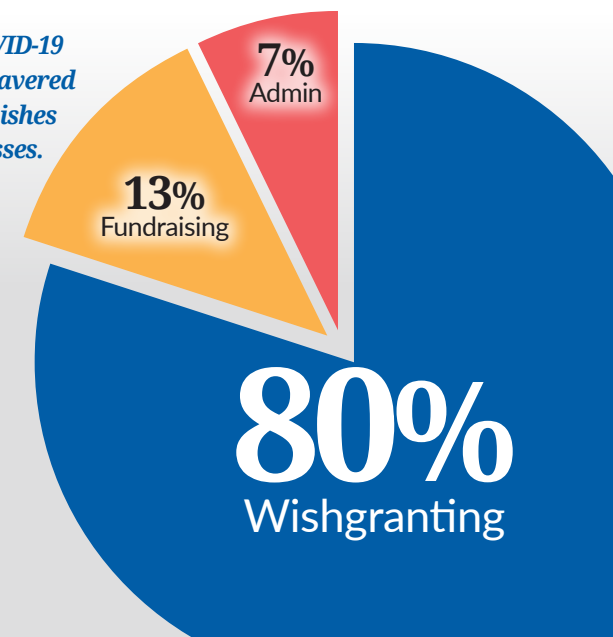
