- Complete assigned Make-A-Wish University Onboarding online courses
- Attend continuing education courses, as offered by Make-A-Wish chapter staff
- Provide and receive ongoing performance evaluation feedback from chapter staff
- As a wish granting volunteer accept assignment of and complete wish discovery for minimum of 3 wish children
