- ★ Answer questions regarding volunteer opportunities, the wish process, and events
- ★ Act as a Make-A-Wish liaison to represent the Southern Nevada Chapter in a professional manner
- ★ Deliver enthusiastic presentations that highlight our mission, vision, and values.
