I wish to meet the Pittsburgh Steelers athletic trainer **Abby, 17** cancer Read about Abby's wish on page 2.



When a child's wish involves the Pittsburgh Steelers, it's usually to meet their favorite player. For Abby, she had a different wish in mind: to shadow the Steelers assistant athletic trainer, Sonia Ruef, during training camp.

This wish has been gradually forming ever since middle school when Abby first learned about the possibility of a career in athletic training.

"I love the Steelers and I want to be an athletic trainer when I grow up," Abby told the Steelers on her wish day. "It combines my love of sports and wanting to help people."

When Abby discovered Sonia – who is one of the few female athletic trainers in the NFL – that solidified her career goals. Sonia's journey showed Abby that her passions were possible, and even after being diagnosed with cancer in January of 2022, Abby stayed determined.

Deciding on her wish helped Abby envision a clear picture of what her future would look like, and her daydreams about her wish day ignited her drive to keep fighting and get through each treatment. A few months before her wish, Abby completed her last cancer treatment and has been in remission ever since. When her wish day finally arrived, she was feeling grounded... she was finally feeling good, and it was better than she ever could have imagined.

The most empowering and inspiring moments for Abby were not only getting to see Sonia in action but also having the opportunity to jump right in and learn the ropes alongside the entire athletic training team.

Decked out in official Steelers gear, Abby was ready to help players get ready for practice in the training room. Throughout the day, she observed and asked questions as players were taped for training exercises, and she spent hours on the sidelines chatting with even more players, coaches and the rest of the training team.

"It's been surreal to see the people I see on television all the time right in front of me," Abby told the Steelers. "I was like 'Oh my gosh,' when I first saw Cam [Heyward]. Then I thought to myself, 'He is very tall.' Getting to meet someone like Cam, being the first person I saw when I walked in the door, I just kept thinking, 'Oh my gosh."

And for Sonia, granting Abby's wish was one of the most memorable experiences in her more than 12 years of working with the Steelers.

"Getting to spend the day with Abby, someone who had to overcome hardships and prevail over adversity, was so rewarding knowing that I could make a positive impact on her life. I loved getting the chance to know her and hear her story. It is something I will always remember."




