OUR 2023 WISH HERO AWARD HONOREE DAVID ORTIZ

David "Big Papi" Ortiz is a shining example of the ability of one person to create and spread joy. His accomplishments on the field as a member of the Boston Red Sox are well known to New Englanders, but it's the difference the Hall of Famer has made off the field that is the real inspiration. David has and continues to support a number of worthy charities and causes, including the David Ortiz Children's Fund. Moved by his 2005 visit with young cardiology patients in his hometown of the Dominican Republic, David started the David Ortiz Children's Fund to provide essential support for children in the Dominican and in New England whose families cannot afford the critical cardiac services they need.

As the Wish Hero Award recipient, we recognize David's commitment to supporting our mission by granting life-changing wishes for children with critical illnesses. David has granted

an impressive 39 wishes through our organization. These wishes have been for children from 21 states and from as far away as Australia. He has been a standout wish granter for two decades, bringing happiness and strength to our wish kids.

In the words of his on-field rival and now colleague and friend, Alex Rodriguez, "ever since I've met you, you've been special to everybody... you change people's lives, that's what you do."

Colby, 11 years old, from Lexington, MA, joins us tonight with his mom, Courtney. When Colby was diagnosed with cancer in 2020, his and his family's lives were turned upside down. Colby fought through over 800 days of chemotherapy and dealt with excruciating side effects of treatment, some of which linger to this day. Through it all, the Horvaths chose to remember how lucky they are, and to keep perspective that, since the outlook for Colby was always positive, things could be a lot worse.

One of the things that kept Colby going through his most difficult days was the idea of his wish to meet a

Disney Imagineer. Colby has long been interested in engineering and spent time during his treatment building elaborate Lego sets and creating with his 3D printer. His family has always loved Disney, so when Colby saw a documentary featuring Imagineers, he was inspired to one day pursue such a career.

Colby and his family had a wish experience they won't soon forget. They met other wish families and created lasting bonds. Colby got to experience a ride with the Imagineer who designed it. He even found a new career path, a Disney Illusioneer, and he's more committed than ever to achieving his goal of landing the illustrious job.

STEPHAN ZEPEDA

Stephan, from Middleton, MA, was diagnosed as a child with Neurofibromatosis Type II. His wish to meet David Ortiz was granted in 2007. Stephan said it was the best day of his life. Sadly, Stephan passed away from the disease last summer. Stephan would have celebrated his 28th birthday last week.

Stephan embodied immense strength and love. His parents, Faby and Doug LeColst, his sister, Madison, and his cousin, Joshua, will present the 2023 Wish Hero Award to Stephan's idol, David Ortiz. Please join us in remembering Stephan tonight.

ELIVETTE GARCIA



Elivette is from Salem, MA, and has lived with a diagnosis of Systemic lupus erythematosus (SLE). In late 2019, her health took a turn for the worse and she became eligible for a wish. Elivette's wish was to go to Hawaii, and when the pandemic halted travel wishes, she patiently waited for two years for her wish to be granted. When travel resumed, Elivette was able to spend her 20th birthday in Hawaii last summer. Highlights of her trip included snorkeling, sightseeing, hiking, swimming, and attending a luau.

Elivette was so moved by her wish journey that she became an intern for Make-A-Wish Massachusetts and Rhode Island last summer, shortly after her wish was granted. She and her fellow interns supported the Mission team. Elivette plans to return for a second internship with our organization later this year.

MACY SULLIVAN

In 2002, Macy had her wish granted when she got a playhouse in her backyard in Milton, MA. The beautiful yellow playhouse was driven cross-country and lifted by crane over her house and into the yard. Macy was (and still is) a huge fan of musicals, especially her favorite, *Annie*. Her volunteer Wish Grantors arranged for the lead from the local school's *Annie* performance to come to Macy's wish reveal to sing "Tomorrow," Macy's favorite song from the musical.

As a student in 2016, Macy interned with Make-A-Wish Massachusetts and Rhode Island. Now 25 years old, Macy works on Broadway, bringing her love of musicals full-circle.
