

CHARLIE'S WISH

I wish to meet the Minnesota Vikings

Charlie, 9 leukemia

In the Spring of 2021, at the age of only 7, Charlie was diagnosed with leukemia. Charlie's dad, Chris, recalled "[after the diagnosis] as we were leaving the pediatrician's office, I was crying, and Charlie grabbed my hand and said, 'it's okay Dad, we've got God'..." Following his diagnosis, Charlie began a two-and-a-halfyear treatment plan which included an especially intense first nine months which left him immunocompromised and unable to attend school.

During this time, Charlie found distraction and a deeper love for the game of football by watching the 2021-2022 National Football League season which is where Charlie's wish to meet the Minnesota Vikings was born!

With the help of the Minnesota Vikings, Charlie's wish to meet the team came true last fall when he was invited to meet the Minnesota Vikings during practice and to even play catch with Adam Thielen and Justin Jefferson! Charlie's mom, Beth, shared, "it was surreal watching the whole thing, it felt like watching a movie...Make-A-Wish gives you hope. They give your child something that you can't. They can make their dreams come true."

At the end of his wish day, after several sweet surprises from the Minnesota Vikings, head coach Kevin O'Connell invited Charlie with the invitation to blow the Gjallarhorn at U.S. Bank Stadium that Sunday against the Chicago Bears!

Charlie, now 9, has a positive prognosis and - as introduced at a Minnesota Viking's game - is truly a CANCER WARRIOR.


