CEO's Message Tim Earley, Make-A-Wish Georgia CEO

Dear Friends of Make-A-Wish Georgia,

It is an absolute honor and pleasure to share our Fiscal Year 2022 Annual Report with you!

When I wrote to you in last fiscal year's annual report, I shared that we were making a bold commitment. We set a goal of granting 1,000 wishes for Georgia children over a two-year period. To achieve this would require granting far more wishes than we ever had in the history of our chapter even amidst the uncertainty caused by Covid-19. Fiscal Year 2022 was the second year of this audacious goal, and on December 17, 2022, Ethan's wish to go to Disney World marked the 1,000th wish! It has been a difficult journey, yet thanks to the hard work of our staff, board, corporate partners, and individual supporters so many sick children and their families were able to experience the life-changing power of a wish.

Mission accomplished!

In 2022, Make-A-Wish Georgia also realized record fundraising levels as more corporations elected to invest in our mission. Leaders like Hank McLarty led a community of individuals in raising \$1.2 million to fund wishes and eliminate a backlog that had been exacerbated by the pandemic.

As our community of support grows, we understand the importance of donor trust in achieving our mission of granting wishes for children with critical illnesses. Our commitment to this trust was further evidenced in 2022 when Make-A-Wish® was recognized as the #1 Most Trusted Nonprofit Operating Locally Across 50 States by Morning Consult. As we head into 2023, wish kids are once again traveling throughout the United States and able to attend large gatherings, such as concerts and sporting events. In Georgia, we have set our sights on generating enough funds to meet the demand of a resurging number of incoming referrals from our partners like Children's Healthcare of Atlanta, Children's Hospital of Georgia-Augusta University, and Memorial Health's Dwaine and Cynthia Willett Children's Hospital of Savannah. While these referrals grow, we continue to extend our reach into all communities throughout our state, which is in line with our vision of granting the wish of every child in Georgia that needs us.

Today, we have 872 Georgia kids waiting for a wish. Please join us in ensuring that we can grant every one of these wishes in addition to fulfilling the wishes of those children and families whose world will be turned upside down tomorrow. With your support, we will be ready. I invite you all to be a part of the incredible and life-changing magic that is a wish.









Wishes by the Numbers


Wishes & Dishes Raised \$1.25 Million
