



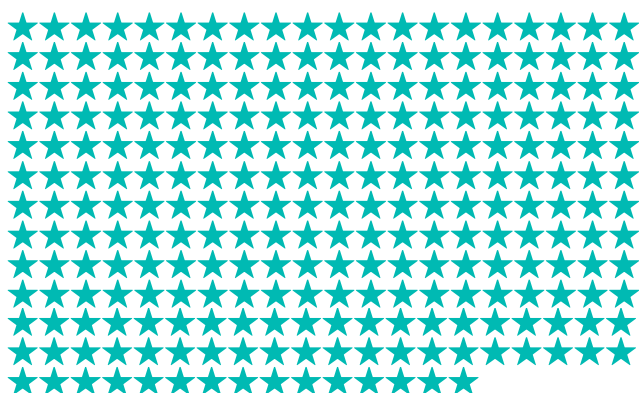

YEAR IN REVIEW



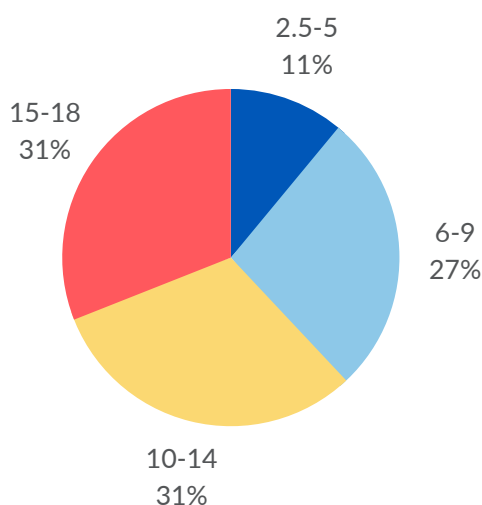
255 Wishes Granted

Together with donors and volunteers, we created 255 life-changing wishes for S.C. children battling critical illnesses. These wishes provided hope, strength and joy.



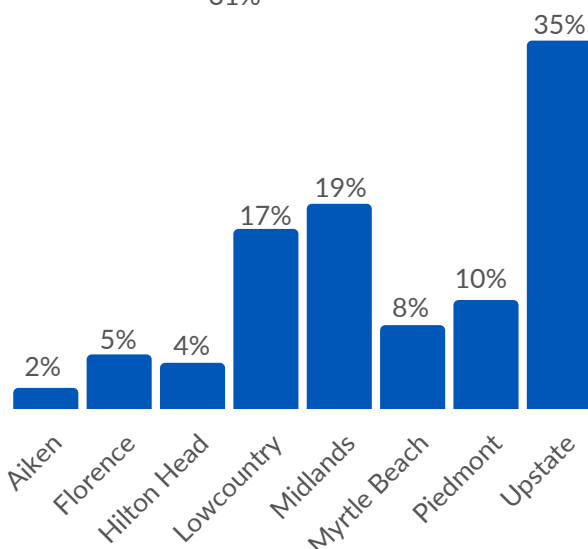
Wishes by Age

We serve children between the ages of 2.5 and 18 years old. This year, 11% were in the youngest bracket, 27% were in the 6 to 9 age group, 31% were pre-teen and 31% were teenagers.



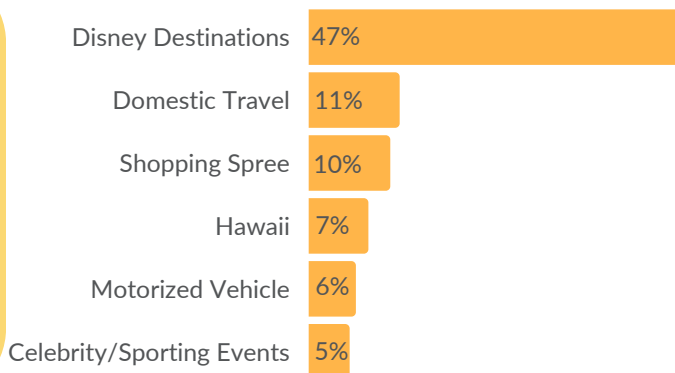
Wishes by Region

We serve children in all 46 counties of S.C. defined by 8 regions. The region with the highest number of wishes granted this year was the Upstate with 35%. Closely following was the Midlands with 19% and the Lowcountry with 17%.



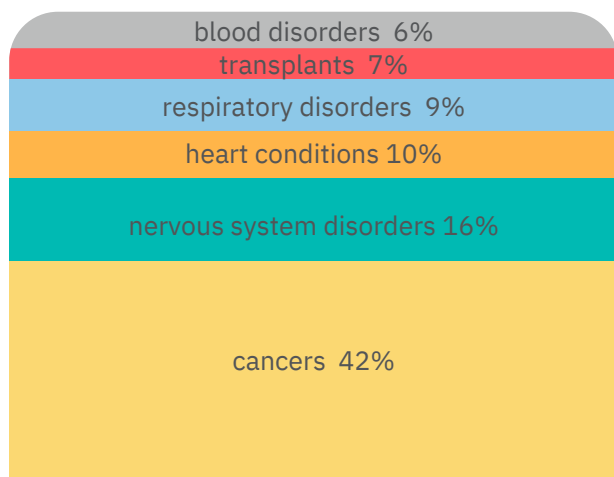
Top 6 Wish Types

Wishes are individually crafted for each child, but some types of wishes are popular. The six most popular types of wishes this year were Disney destinations (#1 at 47%), domestic travel, shopping sprees, Hawaii vacations, motorized vehicles and celebrity/sporting events.



Top 6 Qualifying Medical Conditions

There are many types of critical illnesses that cause a child to qualify for a wish. Cancers were the most referred this year at 42% which includes leukemia and lymphoma.
