NORTHERN - 6% CENTRAL - 75% SOUTHERN - 14%





WISHES BY AGE


Wishes are granted for children between the ages of 2 ½ and 18* years of age when referred due to a critical illness.

Make-A-Wish Arizona is funded 100 percent by donations from organizations, corporate partners, individuals and grants.


In Fiscal Year 2022, we raised a total revenue of \$7.7 MILLION
