





Wish Kid Kabrien

On Valentines Day of 2022, Kabrien was diagnosed with Hodgkin's Lymphoma. In September of 2021, Kabrien's mom noticed that he was losing weight. He soon started complaining of back pain, eventually becoming nauseated and vomiting. His mom took him to the doctor. His blood work came back abnormal, and he was referred to a hematologist and a rheumatologist. At the rheumatologist's office visit he was diagnosed with swollen lymph nodes and a biopsy was performed. It was then that Kabrien found out that he had Hodgkin's Lymphoma.

In the blink of an eye, Kabrien went from a normal life of playing multiple sports to a life filled with doctor appointments and uncertainty. Even though life changed for Kabrien, "He never let cancer or treatment faze him. Unless we told you, you would have never known he was fighting for his life," said Kabrien's mom.

This summer Kabrien was granted his wish to be an Atlanta Braves player for a day. After arriving at Truist Park, Kabrien was greeted with a great big hug by Austin Riley and given an Acuna necklace. He then began his behind-the-scenes tour of the Braves locker room, where Kabrien was able to get in a little baseball drill time with Ron Washington. Next, Kabrien was presented a custom-made jersey from Acuna, his favorite player. After the locker room tour, Kabrien got to stand with the coaches as he watched batting practice. He really racked up on the autographs and got to meet Chipper Jones. After batting practice, Kabrien and his family were escorted to the Delta Club, where they feasted on an unlimited selection of food. Finally, they were escorted to their amazing seats, directly behind home plate. The Braves won the game, and it was followed by an amazing firework show. What a way to end the day! "Kabrien absolutely loved every second of his wish! It was the most amazing experience of his Life," said Kabrien's mom.

Now, Kabrien is nearly one year cancer free, full of energy, and always has a smile on his face.







Wish Kid Ames

Playing in the backyard, riding four wheelers and go carts, playing cops and robbers; these are the things that nine-year-old Ames Lee did on a normal day. On January 6, 2022, this all changed for Ames. Just one week after he had just killed his first deer, Ames was diagnosed with Acute Myeloid Leukemia. "Life was bad," Ames shared. "I was in the hospital for months getting chemo and being separated from my brothers. I didn't get to go to school or participate in any extra-curricular activities. I wasn't able to be around many people. Life was hard."

As part of Ames' treatment journey, he needed a bone marrow transplant. The family began searching for a match. They found their match in Ames' younger brother, Parker. So now, not only did the Lee's have one child undergoing medical procedures, they had two.

"I've worked in healthcare for the past twenty years and have seen many kids get their wishes granted. I never imagined I would have a child that would be on the receiving end of a Make-A-Wish,"

said Wendy Lee, Ames' mom. "Now as a parent having gone through this experience, I understand on a personal level, the mission."

The family began discussing and researching places they would like to visit. Because of Ames' love for the outdoors, nature, and wildlife they decided that Yellowstone would be the perfect place. "I got to see something incredible," said Ames. "It was so different than Mississippi. All the bison, coyotes, bears, and moose we got to see in real life were amazing. I even spotted a momma bear with two cubs playing and that was pretty cool!"

Now that the family has returned home, they are filled with fond memories of their trip. They are already talking about wanting to go again. "We made lots of memories on this trip and at least once a week someone in our family says that they are ready to go back to Yellowstone," said Wendy. "I would like to thank everyone who made this trip possible for our family. It has been such a gift for us. Make-A-Wish is so important for these kids who have a life-changing diagnosis," Wendy added. "Thank you again for making Ames' wish come true!"

Make-A-Wish Mississippi Referral Eligibility

For children with critical illnesses, a wish can help them feel better and give them the hope and strength they need to fight – and even overcome – an illness. It unites families in life-changing moments that help them cope and grow stronger. Your referral is opening the door to endless possibilities for children and their families when they need it most.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR A WISH?

A child with a critical illness who has reached age $2\frac{1}{2}$ and is younger than 18 at the time of referral is potentially eligible for a wish. After a child is referred, Make-A-Wish Mississippi will work with the treating physician to determine the child's medical eligibility for a wish.

WHO CAN REFER A CHILD?

Make-A-Wish Mississippi accepts referrals from:

☆ Children being treated for a critical illness

☆ Parents or legal guardians

Medical professionals (typically a doctor, nurse, social worker or child-life specialist)

☐ Family members with detailed knowledge of the child's medical condition

Our vision is to grant the wish of every eligible child. Your referral and support is crucial to us achieving this vision.
