

Wish Reveal Volunteer

Scope of Position

Wish Reveals typically occur 1-2 weeks before the wish is granted or can happen the same day as the wish. Wish Reveal volunteers play an integral role in the wish granting process because they work directly with our Wish Coordinators to plan, enhance, create, and host Wish Reveals. This is an excellent opportunity to get our wish kids excited about their upcoming wish!

Key Responsibilities

- ★ Plan the reveal in a fun and creative way! It does not need to be complicated but should contain an element of surprise for the wish child.
 - ★ Examples can include opening an envelope with a letter inside, sending the child on a scavenger hunt, having the child open a treasure chest, etc.
 - ★ You can also bring décor to decorate a room at The Wishing Place
- Maintain communication with staff and your Wish Reveal partner
- Review the wish itinerary and details
- ★ With approval, reach out to local businesses to donate items as needed and provide appropriate documentation for a tax receipt
- May involve furniture building and painting
- ★ Take and submit photos of the Wish Reveal experience
- ★ Most importantly, have fun and be creative! This is your time to create a unique experience for the wish child

This Position Is Right for You If...

- ★ You have a strong understanding of the Make-A-Wish mission, vision, values, and standards
- ★ You are organized, a team player, strong communicator, and have time management skills
- ★ You are skilled at events and party planning
- ★ You are compassionate and understanding of different family dynamics

Time Commitment

★ Prep time can vary depending on the Wish. Setup and implementation of the reveal/send-off can take about 2 hours

Location

★ The Wishing Place, Wish family home, or a public place

Training & Requirements

- Volunteer Orientation
- ★ Background Check required
- ★ Depending on the wish child and family, may be required to wear a mask
- ★ Must be 18 years of age or older
