Dear Friends,

It's an exciting time in our **40-year history** to be a part of the Make-A-Wish® Southern Florida family! As we look back on fiscal year 2023, we have a lot to be proud of. Thanks to our supporters, it was our most successful fundraising year ever. We are also nearing a huge accomplishment - the opening of the *Finker-Frenkel Wish House*, which will be our permanent home and a beacon of hope for our community.

We granted **553** life-changing wishes, plus **257** wish assists when wish kids came to our territory to experience their heartfelt wishes. That means wishes are in full swing for the first time since COVID, as we touched more than **800** families with our wish-granting mission. Each wish that we grant is special; however, Charlie's wish to have a custom golf cart is even more memorable as it is our **14,000th** wish! We also recruited **107** new volunteers including **65** trained wish granters that will play an instrumental role in guiding wish families through their wish journeys.

We are confident that with your support, we can continue on the incredible quest to grant the wish of every medically-eligible child in our communities. It is only because of your generosity that we can continue to forever change the lives of courageous children facing critical illnesses.





Sebastian's passion for dinosaurs is what helps him mentally escape from his medical challenges so his greatest wish was to be a paleontologist. After a limousine ride to the USF Science Center in Tampa, Sebastian was welcomed with open arms by Dr. Ryan Carney, a National Geographic Explorer and Assistant Professor of Integrative Biology at USF. He was gifted with a lab coat before embarking on a behind-the-scenes tour of the lab.

Sebastian examined fossils, scanned replicas of dinosaur skulls, and analyzed mummified skin under a microscope. The future paleontologist used x-ray imaging and computer animation to uncover details about prehistoric creatures. Sebastian even 3D printed a "Sebastianosaurus" based on a Brachiosaurus skull, his favorite dinosaur.


