

Meet Tristan





With a limo ride kicking off the day, Sophia was all smiles, enjoying the freedom to pick what made her happiest. For kids like Sophia, a wish is more than a gift—it's a chance to take control, dream big, and just be a kid.

Corporate Partners Making *an Impact*

Alexander's Mobility Services is a shining example of how corporate partners can create lasting impact. Since 2009, their dedicated team has helped grant 44 wishes for children in Orange, Riverside, and San Bernardino Counties. Each year, they rally their employees and community through a charity bake sale, with all proceeds benefiting Make-A-Wish OCIE. In FY24, they granted three more life-changing wishes, including 16-year-old Ethan's wish to attend the Daytona 500. 
