This has allowed the organization to grant a record breaking 212 wishes in FY24, with a goal of 230 wishes in FY25. Mary Elizabeth's connection to the mission began years ago when her cousin's wish was granted as a child. That lived experience has shaped her leadership journey and the powerful results she's delivered over the past six years holding various roles at the chapter.

"I'm honored to lead our chapter into its next phase of growth, working to grant even more wishes for children right here in eastern North Carolina.
