
Lemonade Stand Fundraising Tips

Top Fundraising Tips From These Lemonade Stand Pros:

- Make flyers about your fundraiser for Make-A-Wish and put them wherever you can. Ask local businesses if they will post your flyers.
- Get your friends involved! They can bake things, make posters, post flyers, and hold signs in the neighborhood on the day of your event. Celebrate together!
- It's better not to put prices on items. Simply ask for donations. People give more!
- Ask your parents to post about your "lemonade for wishes" event on social media and invite their friends to grab a cup for a cause.

Math

- Learn about income and expenses.

 Manage the fundraiser from start to finish - from setting goals to marketing the event.







About Make-A-Wish San Diego

Make-A-Wish San Diego is part of the national network of local chapters, each is its own independent organization. Our chapter was founded in 1983 by a local working mom, Jamie Tucker, along with a group of volunteers. It began as a volunteer-run organization that relied on the community to make each child's wish a reality and more than 40 years later, we continue bringing the community together to create life-changing wishes for kids when they need it most. We are able to do this important work thanks to a powerful network of volunteers, donors, medical partners, and staff members.


Every child who is currently dealing with a critical illness and is between the ages of 2½ - 17 years old is eligible to receive a wish. No eligible child will be turned away or will have to wait: once deemed eligible, their wish journey will begin right away!

What do kids wish for?

Our mission is to empower a child to dream up their most heartfelt wish, and our specially trained wish granting volunteers help bring their ideas into focus. Most wishes tend to fall into one of four categories:









How are wishes funded?

Every dollar has been generously donated by individuals, corporations, community partners, and grant funders, or through beguests/planned gifts. We rely on in-kind partners for discounts and donations to enhance every wish experience, and to make our funds go further.

Wishes by the Numbers

1983 year our chapter was founded and began granting wishes to kids in San Diego and Imperial Counties.

5.413 wishes granted for local children since inception.

300 average number of kids in the process of receiving a wish at any given time.

240 average number of wishes granted for kids from other parts of the U.S. who wish to visit San Diego each year.

300+ volunteers who help carry out our mission.
