MAKE-A-WISH® EASTERN NORTH CAROLINA RAISES \$700,000 AT WISH BALL 2025 TO GRANT LIFE-CHANGING WISHES FOR LOCAL CHILDREN

RALEIGH N.C.- Make-A-Wish® Eastern North Carolina announced its annual Wish Ball, held Thursday, August. 7 at Union Hall Raleigh Union Station, raised more \$700,000 to grant wishes for children with critical illnesses across the region. The event marked the most successful fundraiser in the chapter's history.

More than 400 guests attended the disco-themed celebration which featured inspiring wish stories, moving testimonials, and appearances by local wish families. The evening was co-hosted by Marcus Ginyard, former UNC basketball national champion and a former wish recipient, Manny Lee.

The event was led by Mary Elizabeth Bennett, Make-A-Wish Eastern North Carolina's youngest CEO, and a family member. Funds raised at Wish Ball 2025 will directly support wishes for children throughout eastern North Carolina.
