OUR MISSION: Together, we create life-changing wishes for children with critical illnesses.

MAKE-A-WISH EASTERN NORTH CAROLINA AT A GLANCE: Founded in 1986, Make-A-Wish Eastern North Carolina serves children ages **2½-18** battling critical illnesses across 49 counties from the Triangle to the coast.

- More than **4,800 wishes** have been granted since our founding, with almost 300 children still waiting on their wish
- **212 wishes** were granted in FY24 and **230 wishes** in FY25- our two most successful years in chapter history
- There are over **125** volunteers in eastern North Carolina who help grant local wishes
- The average cost of a wish is **\$10,000**
- Make-A-Wish Eastern North Carolina is **100% local**, with all funds and wish kids coming directly from our chapter territories

OUR ROOTS: In 1980, 7-year-old Chris Greicius' dream to become a police officer inspired the creation of Make-A-Wish. Six years later, the Eastern NC chapter opened to bring that hope from the Triangle to the coast. Our first wish was granted in 1986, when 8-year-old Benny Strickland from Roanoke Rapids, bravely battling leukemia, met his favorite professional wrestlers thanks to our chapter.
