The Power of a Wish

Since 1988, Make-A-Wish East Tennessee has granted more than 1700 wishes for children locally, bringing joy and hope to wish kids and their families. We seek to bring every eligible child's wish to life—because a wish is an integral part of a child's treatment journey. Research shows children who have wishes granted can build the physical and emotional strength they need to fight their illness.

Our Mission:
Together, we create life-changing wishes for children with critical illnesses.

Make-A-Wish traces its inspiration to 7-year-old Chris Greicius, a child with leukemia who wished to be a police officer. In 1980, a group of caring individuals came together and made his wish come true. The impact of Chris' wish was felt throughout the community, becoming the inspiration for what is now the Make-A-Wish Foundation. No one could have known that his wish would create a movement of hope that has transformed millions of lives.

In the U.S., a child is diagnosed with a critical illness every 20 minutes. <u>Today, our chapter has more than 100 local children who are waiting for their wish to be granted, and we need the support of our community to grant these wishes when children need them most.</u> Our goal is to ensure every child battling a critical illness receives the joy and hope a wish provides.

Wishes Are Transformational

"If you could have one wish, what would it be?" Through this one simple question, a child can dream and imagine their future. Wishes are limited only by a child's imagination. Each granted wish brings wish kids, their families, volunteers, medical professionals, and their communities on a wish journey to go, give, have, be, or meet. Wishes are not a "nice to have" for a child; wishes are a "need to have."

Wishes Are Local

Make-A-Wish East Tennessee partners closely with local children's hospitals across our region to ensure that children battling critical illnesses are referred and properly qualified. We grant wishes to children ages $2\frac{1}{2}$ to 18 years old. More than 50% of wish children are battling cancer, followed by diseases of the nervous system, sense organs, and transplants. Today 80% of wish kids survive their illness, carrying the transformational impact of the wish experience far into adulthood.



This year, we brought to life 87 magical wishes and are focused on granting the 100+ wishes on our waiting list and the more than 90 wish referrals we receive each year. We work diligently to provide a wish for every child when the child needs it most.

Our goal is to grant wishes for every eligible child diagnosed with a critical illness in our region. Make-A-Wish East Tennessee carefully stewards the financial resources we have available to grant wishes. **Funds raised here, stay here.**
