Scope of Position

Translators facilitate wish experiences for non-English speaking wish kids and their families. Translators have the option of becoming fully trained discovery or reveal volunteers or they can provide short-term support on an as-needed basis.

Key Responsibilities

- ★ Assist staff with translation/interpretation of paperwork and wish process
- ★ Assist staff with translating information for wish families
- ★ Assist on shopping sprees
- ★ Conduct welcome calls
- ★ Conduct Wish Discoveries

This Position Is Right for You If...

- ★ You are Bilingual
- ★ You have strong communication skills
- ★ You have knowledge of the Make-A-Wish mission, vision, values, and standards
- ★ You can work well with staff and other volunteers

Time Commitment

- ★ Varies depending on the request. Make-A-Wish will set the expectation in advance.

Location

- ★ Varies depending on the request. Potential locations include wish family home, public place, The Wishing Place, and/or over the phone.

Training & Requirements

- ★ Volunteer Orientation
- ★ Volunteers will be briefed on the expectations for the translation/interpretation before the commitment of any task.
- ★ Must be the age of 18 or older
