Scope of Position

Wish story writers use their creative writing skills to put the impact of a wish into words. Writers will be provided with a wish story guide containing details about the wish child, their medical journey, wish, and the 'why' of the wish. Make-A-Wish Southern Nevada utilizes these stories to share with the community and request sponsors and donations for the wish.

Key Responsibilities

- ★ Read and review wish stories provided by Make-A-Wish Staff to gain an understanding of our story-telling style
- ★ Write wish stories utilizing the information provided by Make-A-Wish Staff
- ★ Return completed stories to the Make-A-Wish staff within one week of receiving the assignment

- ★ You have strong creative writing skills
- ★ You have the ability to take medical information, family dynamics, wish child information, and the why of the wish and turn it into a compelling story
- ★ If you are tech-savvy and proficient in Microsoft Word

Time Commitment

- ★ 1-2 hour time commitment, depending on the number of stories needed and writing speed

- ★ May come to The Wishing Place to use a computer if one is not available

Training & Requirements

- ★ Volunteer Orientation + submit a sample story for review by staff
- ★ Must be 16 years of age or older
