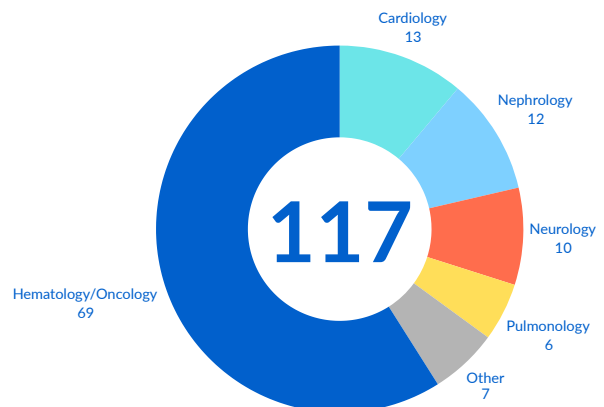

Wishes by Diagnosis

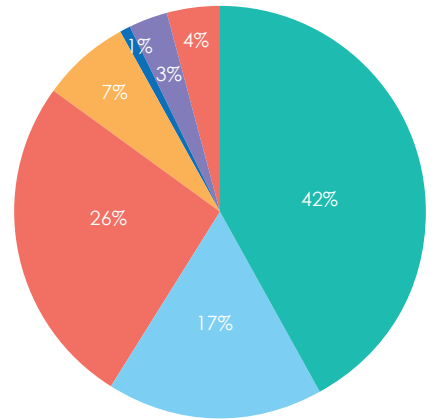

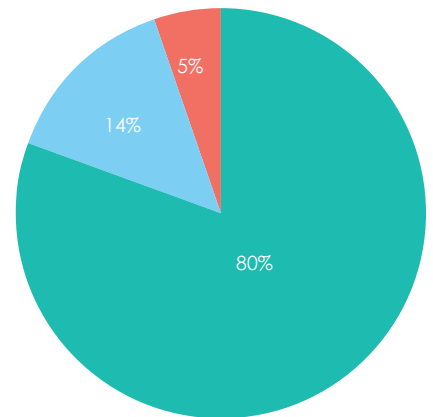

How a Wish to the World Series Gave Me Back My Life

Each morning when I wake up, I'm grateful — grateful to be here, and grateful to be doing what I love again. But not long ago, I wasn't sure I'd ever get back to feeling like a normal kid.

When I was diagnosed with cancer, life as I knew it changed overnight. Suddenly, the activities I loved were gone. The future I had imagined for myself felt uncertain and the path ahead looked terrifying. But through every painful treatment and every sleepless night, I was never truly alone. My incredible doctors and nurses, my family and friends, and my community stood with me. Their support kept me going, even on my worst days.

And there were plenty of bad days — days when I could barely lift my head, days when I didn't want to talk, and days when I wondered if I'd ever get to play, laugh, or simply feel good again. But in the middle of that difficult time, something extraordinary happened.

One day during treatment, representatives from Make-A-Wish visited me in the hospital. They told me I was going to be a Wish Kid, and that I could dream big — as big as I wanted. That one conversation changed everything. Suddenly, I had something to look forward to. I knew exactly what my wish would be: I wanted to go to the Major League Baseball World Series.



That wish became my beacon of hope. It gave me strength during the hardest parts of treatment. And when my wish finally came true, it was even better than I had imagined.

I wasn't just a cancer patient anymore — I was a kid at the World Series, cheering with my family, soaking in the excitement, and watching Freddie Freeman hit a walk-off grand slam at Dodger Stadium. For a few unforgettable days, I was just a kid again, living a dream and making memories that I'll carry with me forever.

This is the power of a wish — and it's possible because of the generosity of people like you. Your support for Make-A-Wish doesn't just create moments of joy — it provides hope, strength, and light in the darkest times for kids like me who are fighting the biggest battles of their lives.

Thank you, from the bottom of my heart, to everyone who makes these wishes possible. You're giving us more than a trip or a special experience — you're giving us the belief that better days are ahead. And that is a gift I'll never forget.

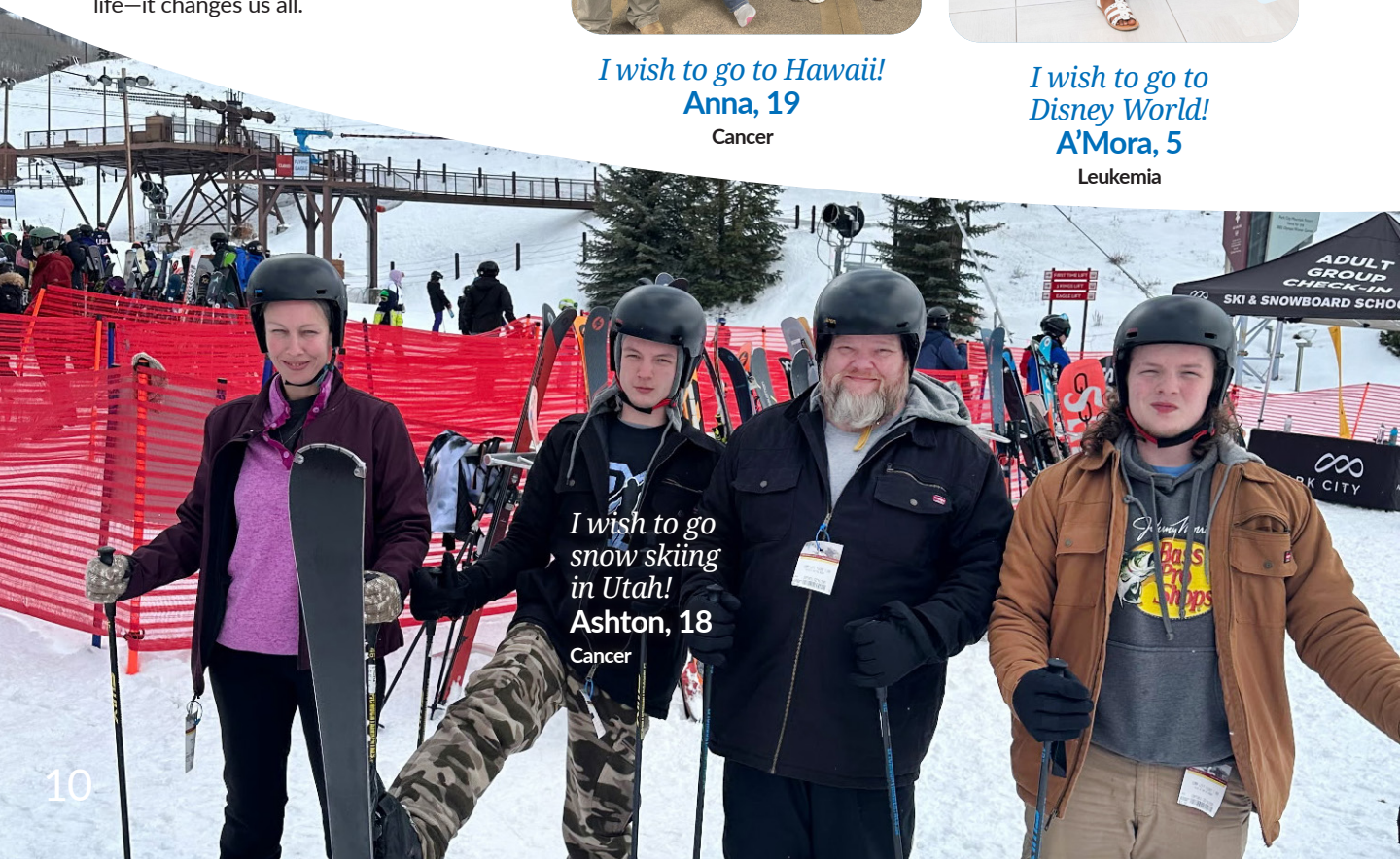

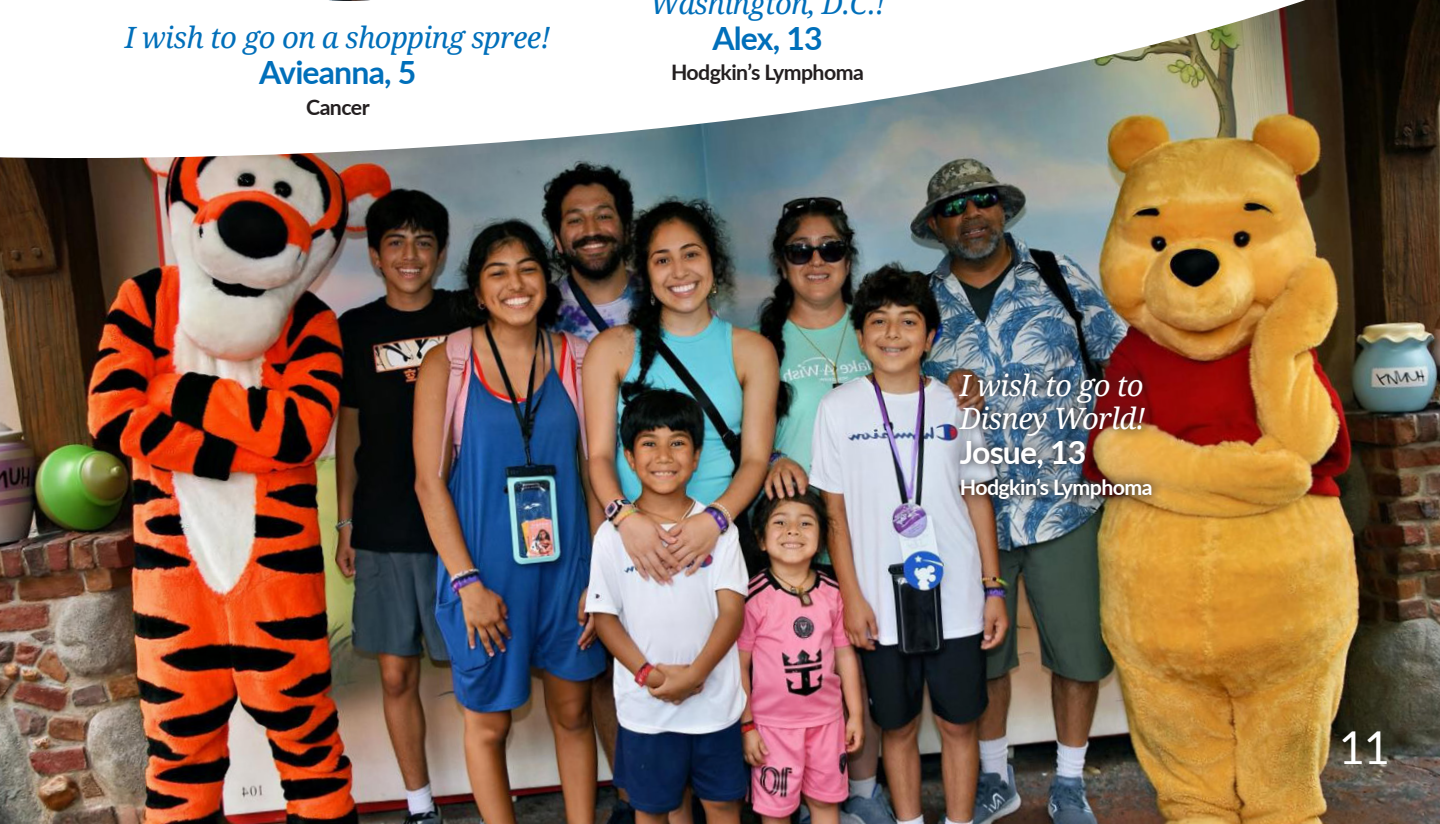

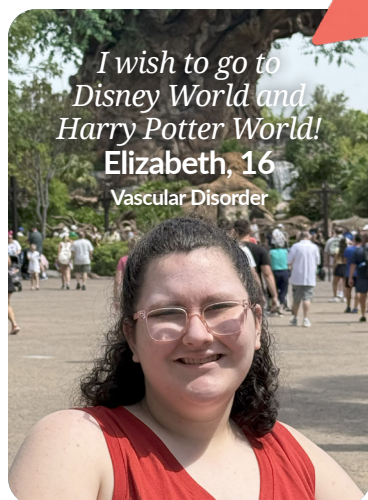

Delta's Story

A Daddy's Girl with a Big Wish

"If it's not how Daddy does it, it's not right," said Delta's mom, Chelsie. Everyone knows Delta is her daddy's girl. But cancer has forced Delta and her father, Hayden, to spend long stretches apart while she receives treatment for leukemia at St. Jude Children's Research Hospital in Memphis—hours away from their Mississippi home.

That distance has made each reunion unforgettable. In one viral moment, Hayden drove three hours to see his little girl. Delta, bald from chemotherapy but determined, pushed through a hitch in her walk to run into his arms. Chelsie caught the reunion on video, and millions of people online witnessed the joy and love between a daddy and his daughter. "Seeing my little girl," Hayden said, "just melted my heart."

The Road to St. Jude

In December 2023, Delta—just three years old—was diagnosed with B-cell acute lymphoblastic leukemia. She began a multi-year treatment plan that will continue through 2026. The road has not been easy—she's endured chemotherapy, brain surgery, and long hospital stays—but through it all, her resilience has amazed everyone around her.

"You see a 3-year-old that hasn't been dealt the best of cards since Christmas '23, but not once has she asked why she's here," Hayden said. "She still has the willpower to push through everything."

Her big sister, Dani, has been by her side, carrying Delta's bags and cheering her on. The family has discovered a new definition of strength—one rooted in love, perseverance, and hope.

The Power of a Wish

In the midst of treatment, Delta learned she would be able to receive a wish from Make-A-Wish Mississippi—a moment her parents describe as life-changing in itself.

When they explained to Delta that she could choose one true wish, she didn't hesitate: "I can go to DISNEY!!!" she shouted with joy.



Delta dreams of meeting every princess, being pampered at the Bibbidi Bobbidi Boutique, and having the ultimate "girls' day" with her family. Talking about her wish fills her with energy and gives her something magical to look forward to at the end of her treatment.

"We sit and talk about this wish often because it keeps us going," Chelsie said. "It gives Delta motivation to keep fighting. Waiting for a wish gives us hope, excitement, and something BIG to look forward to."

Why Wishes Matter

For families like Delta's, a wish is not just a trip or a gift—it's a turning point. Wishes bring joy in the hardest times, unite families, and remind children that they are more than their illness.

Every wish granted by Make-A-Wish Mississippi is made possible by donors, volunteers, and community partners who believe in the power of hope. On average, the cash cost of a wish is \$6,500, and thanks to supporters, 117 children across Mississippi experienced the transformative joy of a wish last year alone.

Delta's story is proof of why Make-A-Wish exists. While medicine treats the body, wishes lift the spirit and remind children to dream again.

For Delta and her family, the promise of Disney is more than a vacation. It's a light at the end of a long road, a celebration of resilience, and a symbol of the love and community that surround them.

Refer a Child to receive a life-changing wish

Who Qualifies?

Children must meet these criteria at the time of referral:

- Diagnosed with a critical or life-threatening illness (i.e. a progressive or malignant condition) that currently places the child's life in jeopardy
- Older than 2½ years old and younger than 18 years old

Who Can Refer?

To respect the privacy of families we serve, children who may be eligible to receive a wish can be referred by:

- Medical professionals such as providers (doctor, nurse practitioner, or physician assistant), nurse, social worker or child-life specialist.
- Parents or legal guardians.
- Family members with detailed knowledge of the child's current medical condition.
- Children being treated for a critical illness may also refer themselves if they are capable of doing so.

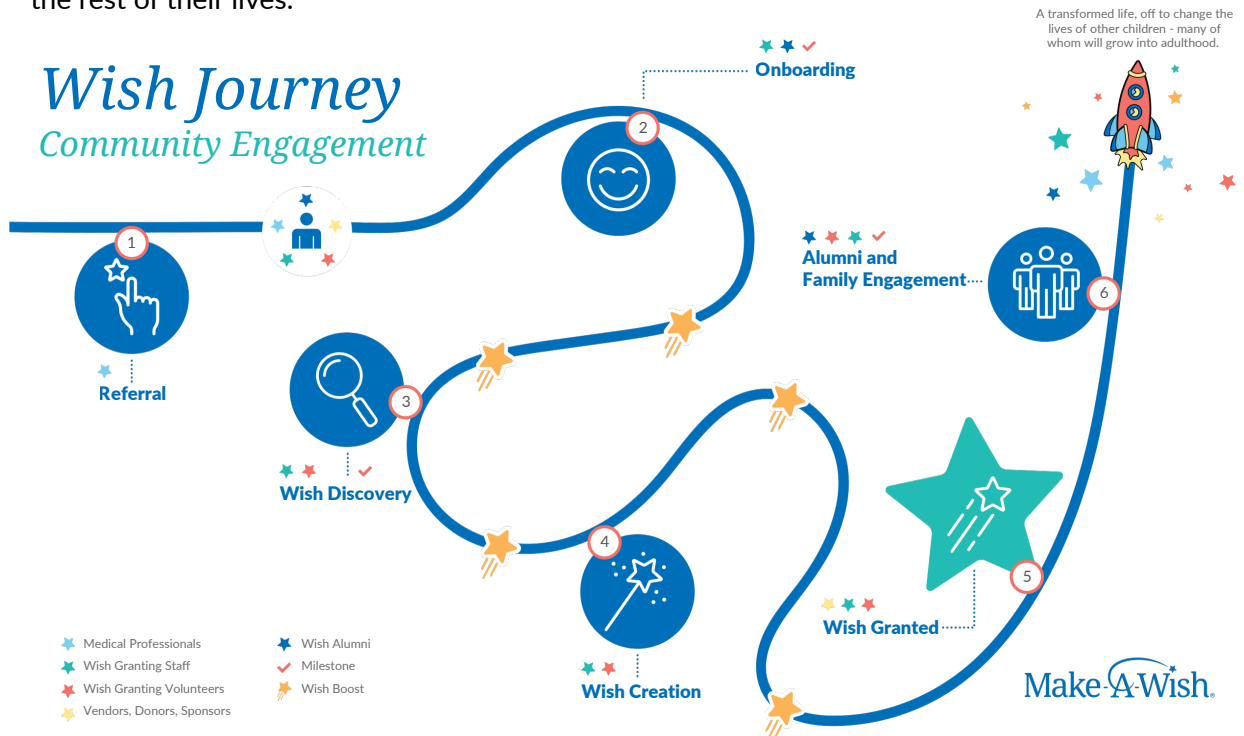

Athletic Director Zac Selmon welcomed wish families to campus for Halloween festivities, where kids enjoyed trick-or-treating with student athletes throughout the athletic complex. Later in the year, MSU Head Football Coach Jeff Leiby, serving as honorary chair of the Starkville Evening of Wishes, hosted wish kids and their families at each spring football scrimmage game. At the Evening of Wishes event, MSU student athletes escorted local wish kids down the red carpet, where Coach Leiby presented each child with a “Hero Award” for their extraordinary courage in fighting critical illnesses.

The impact didn't stop there. Our 2025 Home Runs for Wishes Campaign raised more than \$70,000 to grant life-changing wishes across Mississippi. Thanks to the generosity of Presenting Sponsor, Simmons Erosion Control, and the inspiring leadership of MSU Baseball standouts Hunter Hines and Stone Simmons, a season of baseball became a season of impact.

As Hunter chased down—and ultimately broke—the MSU career record for home runs, donors pledged gifts for every home run he hit, fueling excitement while funding wishes. Meanwhile, pitcher Stone Simmons partnered with a charitable foundation to turn each strikeout and team win into even more support for wish kids. Together, these efforts—along with Simmons Erosion Control's leadership—transformed sports milestones into a movement of hope.

Through this remarkable partnership, Mississippi State Athletics, its student athletes, and its staff have united around our mission, helping us bring the joy of a wish to children across our state.

Wish Upon a Par

How One Family's Support for Make-A-Wish Came Full Circle

Four years ago, Kirk Morgan sent a message to his family's group chat with big news: he was starting a golf tournament to benefit Make-A-Wish Mississippi. A lifelong lover of kids, Kirk was passionate about helping an organization that brings hope and joy to children facing critical illnesses.

He wanted the tournament to have a name that captured the spirit of the mission. After tossing around ideas, his daughter, Betsy Fulton, chimed in with the suggestion that stuck—"Wish Upon A Par." What started as a creative family brainstorm became the name of an annual tradition that raised vital funds for wishes.

What the family didn't know then was just how personal Make-A-Wish Mississippi would become to them.

Ace's Journey

Before he was even born, Ace's parents, Betsy and Jon Fulton, received news that changed their lives forever. During pregnancy, Ace was diagnosed with a rare and complex heart condition. His cardiologist explained that she had never seen a heart quite like his: the right side had never developed, leaving the left side to carry the load for the rest of his life.



This meant medications, blood thinners, and restrictions from contact sports—things most kids take for granted. But if you ask Ace's mom, she'll tell you that hasn't stopped him from tackling his older siblings with his best wrestling moves. His condition requires careful monitoring, especially staying hydrated, but Ace approaches life with a contagious energy and joy.

A Wish Becomes Possible

At first, Ace's family never considered that he might qualify for a wish. "I thought Make-A-Wish was only for terminal children," his mom shared. It wasn't until her dear friend, Nikki Smith, encouraged them to explore the process that they learned the truth: wishes are for children battling critical illnesses, giving them hope and strength for the journey ahead.

From the very first call, the Fultons felt the magic. Volunteers and staff guided them through every step with kindness, making the experience simple, joyful, and full of anticipation. When Ace realized his wish was to meet Mickey Mouse was granted, his face lit up. "His eyes just widened with excitement," his mom said.

A Trip Full of Magic

From the moment they left for their trip, the Fulton family experienced what it truly means to be treated like royalty. Every detail was handled, every moment filled with magic.

"The VIP treatment was incredible," his mom recalled. "The kids—and us parents too—felt so special. Make-A-Wish Mississippi made everything easy and hassle-free."

For Ace's parents, the most moving part wasn't just seeing the joy on Ace's face—it was watching his siblings light up as well. "Ace has been through so much, but really, his siblings have too. They've endured separations from us, periods of quarantine to protect Ace, and missed out on so many experiences. They deserved this trip and the magic almost as much as he did."

Full Circle

Today, the family remains deeply committed to Make-A-Wish Mississippi. What began as supporting through the Wish Upon A Par Golf Tournament has become a mission that's now part of their family story.

"No question, I would recommend Make-A-Wish Mississippi to anyone," Ace's mom shared. "Helping bring joy, hope, and magic to these children and their families is not just a good deed—it's an honor."



4th Annual Wish Upon a Par

The 4th Annual Wish Upon A Par Golf Tournament, held in Philadelphia on Friday, September 5, 2025, was a remarkable day of generosity, community spirit, and life-changing impact. 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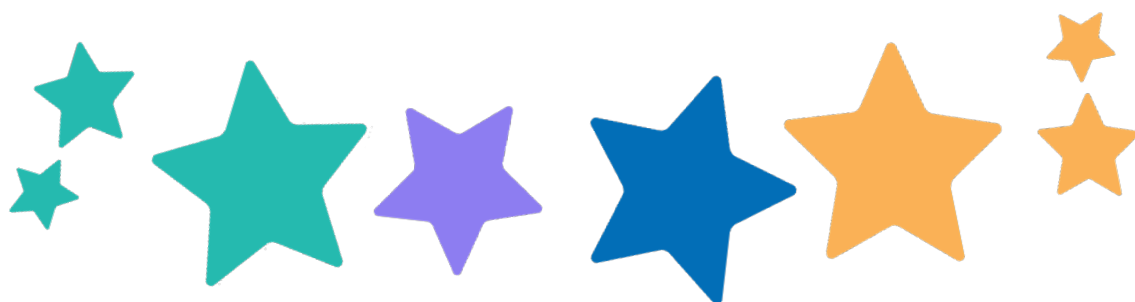

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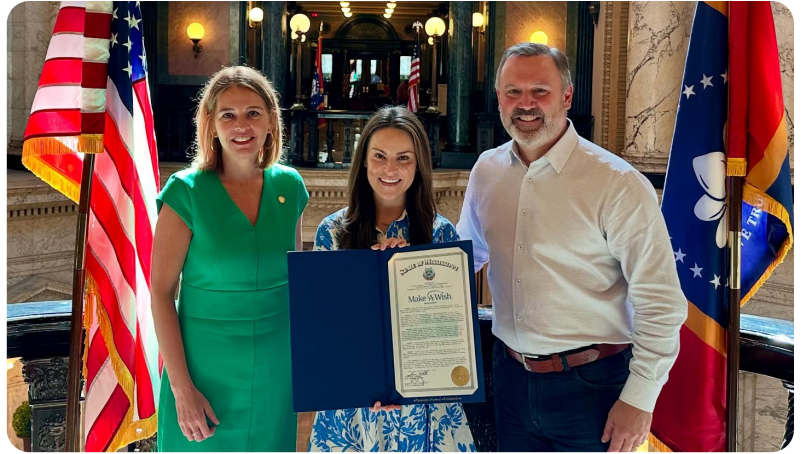

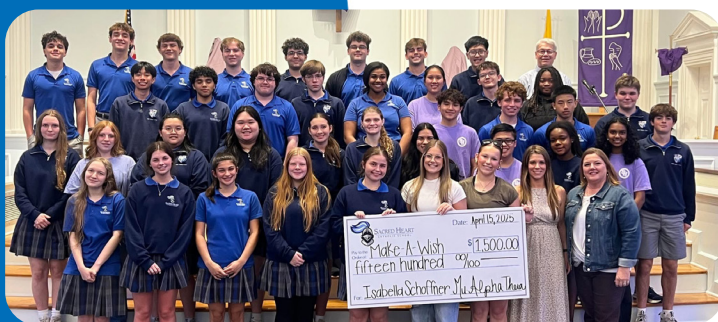
