

How Make-A-Wish[®] Helped Duncan *Serve Comfort*



Duncan ready to give back to patients.

When Duncan was receiving treatments for leukemia at UPMC Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh, the worst part, he says, was "that I couldn't really eat the food I wanted to eat." Hospital meals quickly grew monotonous, and treatments diminished his appetite. He found himself craving specific foods at odd hours, sometimes long after the cafeteria closed or for dishes it didn't have.

Duncan found that one of the few things that helped him feel "himself" during treatment was eating food from outside the hospital. His family drove all over town to find whatever he was craving. "Not every family is able to do that, and I never forgot that."

So, when the time came for Duncan to meet with Make-A-Wish and talk to his wish volunteers, he knew he wanted to use his wish to bring comfort to kids just like him. Together, Duncan and Make-A-Wish[®] Greater Pennsylvania and West Virginia helped launch Duncan's Diner, a fund through UPMC Children's Hospital Foundation to provide hospitalized pediatric patients on the oncology floor with meal delivery gift cards.

Today, Duncan is in complete remission and is continuing his work with Duncan's Diner, making sure children in the hospital can order their special meal and feel a sense of normalcy.







Green's Garage Annual Holiday Party Raises Record High for Make-A-Wish

When you walk into Bob Green's vintage car garage in Orwigsburg, Pa., you may feel like you've stumbled into a bygone era. From the countless classic cars to the nostalgic signage and vintage décor, the only thing that shines brighter than the polish on these cherished artifacts is the Green family's passion for supporting Make-A-Wish.

The annual fundraiser was started by Bob's late wife, Judy, and is now hosted and organized by him and his adult children Kyrsten and Jordan, with countless members of the Schuylkill County community and beyond attending to support the cause. This year's event was held on Dec. 8, 2025, and guests perused the classic collections while enjoying food and drinks, live entertainment, a raffle and silent auction and an incredible live auction.

But the real treat was when the crowd quieted to listen to wish kid Jaxon and his dad tell their life-changing wish story. When they were finished, a surprise guest took to the stage — Linda Pauling, who co-founded Make-A-Wish in April of 1980 after her community came together to grant the wish of her son, Chris Grecius.

The night ended with a stunning, record total of \$550,000 raised for local wishes.

A Wish That Sparked a Lifetime of Giving

Conor was diagnosed with a gastrointestinal disorder in 2011, beginning a long journey of treatments, hospital visits and uncertainty.

But thanks to dedicated physicians in Erie and Pittsburgh — Conor has continued to respond well to treatment.

During this initial phase of treatment, his doctor at UPMC Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh referred him to Make-A-Wish. In April of 2016, Conor's wish came true. He spent an unforgettable afternoon in New York City with his favorite late night talk show host. The experience lifted his spirits so deeply that he promised to pay it forward.

But giving was already in his nature. Starting at age nine, Conor turned his birthday parties into charitable events for kids in hospitals — raising funds, donating handmade ornaments and collecting more than 1,100 comic books.

For his efforts, Conor was recognized by WJET-TV, Kohl's Care and the NWPA Association of Fundraising Professionals, which named him "Outstanding Young Philanthropist" in 2016. Since receiving his wish, Conor and his supporters have raised thousands of dollars each year to help grant wishes to other children with critical illnesses.
