A wish creates lasting joy—and a community that continues long after the wish is granted.



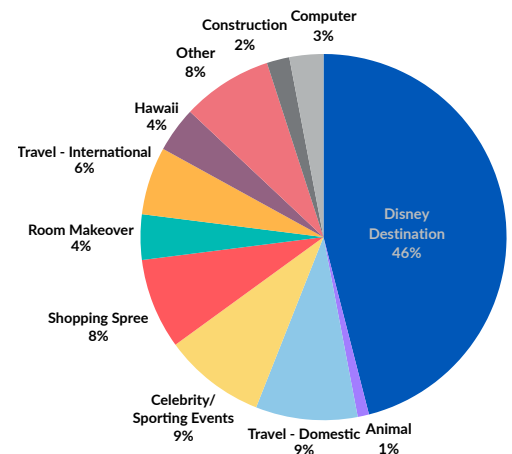
